Ordering Information:

We ask that you order early because orders are filled on a "first come first served basis" and we don't wish to disappoint you. Planting guidelines will be included with your shipment.

ALL orders must be prepaid in full by cheque or money order. Important:

Lily bulb orders for spring delivery must be post marked before April 15.

Spring orders are shipped the last week in April.

Orders postmarked <u>after</u> April 15 will be deferred and filled with the fall orders.

5% discount may be applied to lily bulb orders <u>(for fall delivery only)</u> if postmarked before September 1.

Shipping of fall orders begins September 23.

Customers wishing to pick up their fall bulb orders may do so **September 25 – September 30 during regular business hours.**

Orders postmarked after September 30 will be returned to sender.

Guarantee: Our bulbs are of the highest quality; we guarantee safe delivery and will replace items which are not received in good condition. We can **not** be responsible for planting conditions or cultural care.

Lilies from Hillcrest Harmony Flowers

The format of the lily bulb listing is: Name [Classification] Hybridizer's Name [Height of mature plants] Description [Season of bloom for Zones 1, 2 & 3; [E] = Early; [EM] = Early Mid-season; [M] = Mid-season; [LM] = Late Midseason; [L] = Late; [Catalogue #] [Price]

Asiatic Hybrids

Asiatic hybrids fall into Division 1 and are classified according to the position of the bloom; 1a ... up facing, 1b ... out facing, and 1c ... down facing. Example: Edith 1a. One can tell quickly that Edith is an Asiatic hybrid with up facing blooms.

Brushstroke [1a] Columbia-Platte [1m] Yellow with deep purple brush stroke. [LM]

Fall. [# Bru 70] [\$5.00] or [3 for \$13.00]

Burnished Rose [1c] C. F. Patterson [1m] Bronze pink with medium sized blooms with re-flexed petals. [EM]

Fall. [# Bur 50] [\$5.00]

Centuria [1a] A. J. Porter [1m] Introduced in 2005 to commemorate the Saskatchewan centennial; this lily has been a favourite in our garden for a few years. The strong stems proudly display an inflorescence of star shaped blooms. Each bloom is soft yellow with a dark yellow blush in the center of each petal. Brown spots are sprinkled evenly over most of the bloom. [M]

Fall. [# Cen 80] [\$10.00]

Cherished [1a] Van der Salm [75 cm] Dark pink with a few fine spots at the center of the petals. [LM]

Fall. [# Che 50] [\$5.00] or [3 for \$13.00]

Cheryl Ann [1b] G. Hinz [75-80 cm] An introduction from northern Saskatchewan this variety has peachy –apricot blooms with maroon spots. Twisted petals reflex. [LM]

Fall. [# Che 80] [\$6.00]

China [1a] Columbia Platte Lilies [75 cm] Double flower form. purple/pink with a touch of ivory-white at the center of each petal. [EM]

Fall. [# Chi 70] [\$5.00]

Chippawa Star [1b] V. Weiser [1m] Dark red blooms with dark spots. [M] Fall [# Chi 90] [\$10.00]

Visit some of the seminars and lily shows for a chance to meet the Lily Family

Coppertone [1a] F. Fellner [90 cm] The blooms are a coppery or bronze colour with white nectaries, a few spots. [M]

Fall. [# Cop 55] [\$5.00]

Delisle Dandy [1b] E. Sanders [1m] Blooms of very dark near black red make this one a striking addition to the lily plot. [M]

Fall. [# Del 55] [\$6.00]

Desert Peach [1a] [90 cm] Striking colour of rosy pink on petal tips and in the flower throat with rich cream coloured mid petals set this lily apart from the rest. [M] **Fall.** [# Des 30] [\$6.00]

Edith Cecilia [1a] C. F. Patterson [1m] An old favourite among Dr. Patterson's early introductions. Nodding orange buff/pink blooms hold the attention of a passerby.

Fall. [# Edi 50][\$15.00]

Flirt [1a] Columbia-Platte [90 cm] Large green-yellow blooms with pencil stroke brush marks make this lily the conversation piece of any garden. [M] Fall. [# Fli 50] [\$6.00]

Golden Melody [1a] Vletter & den Haan [90 cm] Yellow with a small orange flush on the lower part of the petals. A few red-brown spots. [M] **Fall**. [# Gol 56] [\$5.00]

Gran Cru [1a] Vletter & Den Haan [1m] Brilliant yellow blooms with medium red blush at the base of the interior of the petals. [M] **Fall.** [# Gra 40] [\$5.50]

Hillcrest Cynthia [1a-b] Our 2004 introduction. The colour is a light apricot with the lower half of the petals splattered with deep burgundy round and elongated spots. The blooms are large measuring approximately 172-175 mm in diameter. Strong 1-1.5m stems with medium green foliage hold an inflorescence of as many as 25 well spaced blooms. [LM]

Fall. [# Hil 50] [\$9.00]

Honey Pink [1b-c] F. Fellner [75 cm] Still considered to be a "bit unusual" this honey amber flush with pink is a striking colour in the lily garden. [M] **Fall.** [# Hon 40] [\$5.00] or [3 for \$13.00]

Honey Queen [1b] C. F. Patterson [1m] An old favourite in our garden this lily has small blooms of honey amber with rosy pink petal tips; self coloured spots towards the center of the bloom. [EM]

Fall. [# Hon 50] [\$10.00]

Drop by to visit our plot of lilies during the blooming season.

Ikaria (AKA Malta) [1a] [90 cm] Large blooms of pink purple, with a deeper pink tone in the throat. [M]

Fall. [# Ika 50] [\$6.00] or [3 for \$15.00]

Indian Brave [1a] H. J. Hartle [90 cm] Large yellow blooms with large brown spots and tan blush. [LM]

Fall. [# Ind 30] [\$5.50]

Indian Princess [1a] Hartle-Gilman Gardens [1.1m] Blooms are pale yellow green fading to white. The black spots on the centre of each petal form a perfect band on the whole floret. [LM]

Fall. [# Ind 60] [\$6.00] or [3 for \$15.00]

Iowa Rose [1b] R. Prochaska [1m] An outstanding pink with creamy yellow to pale orange throat with a few dark spots in the central third of each petal. [M] **Fall.** [# Iow 50] [\$5.00] or [3 for \$13.00]

Latvia [1a] [90 cm] A yellow petals make an excellent background for the black speckles that cover much of the bloom.

Fall. [# Lat 65] [\$6.00]

Lemon Stardust [1a] Columbia -Platte [1m] Yellow flowers with a unique splattering of burgundy speckles in the centres and extending outward along the petal edges. [M]

Fall. [# Lem 60] [\$7.00]

Lemon Tree [1a-b] Hoffgaarde [90 cm] As the mid season flowering season begins to wane the soft yellow with large blooms is a welcome addition to the lily garden. The red pollen enhances the already striking display. [LM]

Fall. [# Lem 85] [\$6.00]

Miss Alice [1a] J. Wadekamper [1.2m] Large bronze /tan blooms show a hint of yellow, no spots. Long pedicels. Strong stems. [M]

Fall. [# Mis 50] [\$5.00] or [3 for \$13.00]

Molly [1a] Columbia-Platte [75 cm] Small delicate flowers of chiffon orange. [M] **Fall.** [# Mol 50] [\$5.00]

Monte Negro [1a] Gebr. Vletter & J. A. den Haan [90 cm] A favourite with many who prefer a dark red lily. [M]

Fall. [# Mon 57] [\$6.00]

Montreaux [1a] Gebr. Vletter & J. A. den Haan [90 cm].

A deep pink with a hint of rose-purple and only a few spots will draw attention to this lily. [M]

Fall. [# Mon 75] [\$6.00]

Morden Butterfly [1c] W. G. Ronald [1-1.2 m] Cherry red blooms on strong stems make this lily a candidate for the garden back drop. [M]

Fall. [# Mor 30] [\$8.00] or [3 for \$21.00]

Perky Peach [1a] [90 cm] Large blooms of peach/orange attract attention to this lily. [EM]

Fall. [# Per 50] [\$4.50] or [3 for \$11.00]

Phyllis Irene [1a] [1m] Our 2002 introduction is named for a long time lily grower/hybridizer/friend Phyllis Pierrepont who shared this lily with us sometime ago. Large yellow blooms have small dark purple-red brush marks with elongated reddish spots. [LM]

Fall. [# Phy 45] [\$6.00] or [3 for \$15.00]

Pink Champagne [1b-c] A. J. Porter [1.1m] Bronze pink blooming late in the season this one is a good lily for the back row of a perennial border. [LM] **Fall.** [# Pin 50] [\$5.00] or [3 for \$13.00]

Plum Crazy [1a-b] OBF [90 cm] An old favourite that makes a striking display with its creamy off white petals faced with a burgundy pink brush mark. [M] **Fall.** [# Plu 50] [\$6.00]

Purple Reign [1a] J. Wadekamper [1m] White with a purple brushstroke. A good contrast for purple delphiniums and a welcome addition to the white lily row in the lily garden. [M]

Fall. [# Pur 70] [\$12.00]

Pussycat [1c] P. H. Clas [90 cm] Deep rose blooms with dark orange centers. [M] **Fall.** [# Pus 70] [\$20.00]

Red Velvet [1c] Stone & Payne [1.5m] Deep red with few spots. A great variety for the back ground planting. Strong stems. [LM] **Fall.** [# Red 95] [\$6.00] or [3 for \$16.00]

Robinson's Comet [1b-c] E. Robinson [1.5m] Deep purple-pink flowers with a small orange mark on the central portion of each petal. A striking background for the perennial garden. [LM]

Fall. [# Rob 50] [\$6.00]

Lilies are a welcome and pleasing addition to a perennial border.

Asiatic hybrids perform best when planted and /or transplanted in fall.

Remove the anthers from the blooms before the pollen dries for when using lilies for arrangements BUT do not remove when exhibiting in lily shows.

Sally Jo Ann [1b] Simonet/Fellner [75 cm] Cardinal red with few spots. [M] **Fall.** [# Sal 55] [\$5.00] or [3 for \$13.00]

Sheri Katherine [1a] Fellner [90 cm] Coppery orange, large flowers. Outstanding in the landscape. [M]

Fall. [# She 50] [\$5.00] or [3 for \$13.00]

Shirley [1a] Gebr. Mak [1.5m] Yellowish green with dark red mark in the lower part of the petals. [M]

Fall. [# Shi 70] [\$5.50]

Sinai [1a] Bischoff-Tulleken Lelies [0.7m] Large yellow orange blooms are unspotted with dark brown pollen. [EM]

Fall. [# Sin 25] [\$4.50] or [3 for \$11.00]

Skydancer [1c] A. J. Porter [1.5-2 m] Yellow petals with brown spots recurve slightly making this a nice lily for the garden at the end of the season. [L]

Fall. [# Sky 50] [\$5.50]

Snowbrook [1a-b] Cebeco [80 cm] Strong stems support this cluster of small clean white blooms. No spots or pollen on this one!! [EM]

Fall. [# Sno 60] [\$5.00] or [3 for \$13.00]

Sunday Parfait [1a] [90 cm] One of our introductions. The top half of the petals are muted fuchsia pink with the lower half being a deep yellow orange. The attractive inflorescence on sturdy stems attracts the attention of many visitors. [M]

Fall. [# Sun 29] [\$10.00]

Sungod [1b] E. Brooman [90 cm] Considered by some to be the "blackest asiatic lily" because it does not have the red sheen of Summer Night. The blooms re-curve unlike those of Summer Night. [M]

Fall. [# Sun 30] [\$15.00]

Susan Eileen [1a] A. J. Porter [90 cm] Apricot orange with a hint of rose as the buds grow. Some spots on the lower half of the petals. [EM]

Fall. [# Sus 50] [\$5.00]

Sutter's Gold [1c] J. de Graaff [90 cm] Yellow with spots on the lower half of the petals. Petals reflex. [M]

Fall. [# Sut 50] [\$5.00] or [3 for \$13.00]

Tahitian Dawn [1a] [90 cm] Copper coloured but without pollen. Flowers are of a good size for corsage use. [M]

Fall. [# Tah 50] [\$4.50] or [3 for \$11.00]

The bloom season for lilies can be extended by growing lilies from all Divisions; e.g. Div. II bloom first, then Div. I, followed by Div. VIII.

Tinkerbell [1c] L. D. Marshall [1m] Flowers are red purple which re-curve to display tiny magenta spots on the inner petals. [EM]

Fall. [# Tin 45] [\$10.00]

White Princess [1c] C. F. Patterson [1.2m] Creamy white with fine purple spots. A welcome addition to the perennial border. [M]

Fall. [# Whi 60] [\$6.00]

Yellow Joy [1a] F. Fellner [1m] A lily that was an instant favourite when we were searching for up facing "yellows". The yellow blooms have green throats with black spots over the lower half of each petal. [M]

Fall. [# Yel 40] [\$5.00]

Pixies

And other short Asiatic hybrid varieties suitable for containers, rock gardens, or the front row of the perennial border.

Crimson Pixie [1a] E. A. McRae [40 cm] This short lily holds its vivid orange red unspotted flowers proudly on strong stems. This one is recommended for container & rock garden plantings or for the front of the perennial border. [EM] **Fall.** [# Cri 50] [\$5.00]

Lemon Cupcake [1a] Van der Salm [60 cm] Large light yellow blooms are supported on strong sturdy stems . A mid size plant for a "filler" in the perennial border. [EM]

Fall. [# Lem 30] [\$5.00]

Yellow Pixie [1a] [30 cm] Bright yellow flowers on short strong stems. [M] Fall. [# Yel 58] [\$5.00] or [3 for \$13.00]

Yum Yum [1a] [50 cm] Deep rosy pink petals accented with white on lower third of the petals and lots of spots make this lily a gem in the garden. [EM] Fall. [# Yum 65] [\$6.00]

We do not keep a supply of bulbs on hand so we request that you place orders in accordance with our deadlines. We ask that ALL orders be prepaid with cheque or money order.

Triploid and Tetraploid Asiatic Hybrids

If you are a lily grower and would like to try your hand at hybridizing you may want to include some these in your program.

Triploid lilies have three times the normal haploid set of chromosomes with tetraploid lilies having four times the normal haploid set of chromosomes.

This characteristic is exhibited in the plant with enhanced substance in the flower petals and stronger stems and heavier foliage.

Angel's Touch [1a] van der Salm [90 cm] An instant favourite with its interesting colour combination of pink, rose and yellow. [M] **Fall.** [# Ang 50] [\$6.00]

Bold Knight [1b] H. E. Sunley [1.1m] A natural triploid with deep red flowers make this an attractive garden lily. Strong stems. [M]

Fall. [# Bol 50] [\$5.00] or [3 for # 13.00]

Gran Paradiso [1a] Vletter & den Haan [1m] Heavily textured cup-shaped flowers of orange-red give a fluorescent appearance to the area of the garden where this lily is planted. Flowers are unspotted and are long lasting in arrangements. [EM] **Fall.** [# Gra 50] [\$6.00]

River Rouge [1a] Van der Salm [90 cm] Large deep red with a hint of burgundy is the colour of the large blooms of this lily. The lower part of the bloom is sprinkled with dark spots. [EM]

Fall. [# Riv 65] [\$6.00]

Super Nova [1a] Cebeco [90 cm] Large blooms of bronzed orange, with no spots, are held proudly by strong stems. [M] **Fall.** [# Sup 30] [\$6.00] or [3 for \$15.00]

Martagon Hybrids Division II

Amelita [II] F. Tarlton [1m] The re-curved blooms are purple pink held proudly on long pedicels. The pollen is yellow providing a striking contrast. [E] **Fall.** [# Ame 50] [\$20.00]

Autumn Color [II] E. Robinson [1-1.3m] Yellow blooms with dark maroon spotting. [E]

Fall. [# Aut 70] [\$30.00]

Dalhansonii [II] [1m] Dark reddish brown. Petals reflex. [E] **Fall.** [# Dal 40] [\$10.00]

Moonyeen [II] F. Tarlton [1m] Purple–pink blooms with reddish spots and orange pollen. [E]

Fall. [# Moo 70] [\$30.00]

Rosalinda [II] F. Skinner [1m] Deep rose pink with light spots. [E] **Fall.** [# Ros 35] [\$25.00]

Terrace City Hybrids [II] N. E. Pfeiffer [1m] Gold blooms with pink, some spots: small delicate blooms. [E] **Fall.** [# Ter 50] [\$15.00]

Martagon lilies are shade tolerant and will do well in areas with only 6 hours of direct sunlight.

<u>Aurelians</u> formerly listed as Trumpet Hybrid

Division VI

White Henryi [VI d] L. Woodriff [1.5m] A fragrant lily with white flowers which display deep orange centers. We will ship this variety in the spring because it transplants with better success if dug Early in spring. [LM]

Spring only. [# Whi 40] [\$12.00] or [3 for \$34.00]

Trumpet & Trumpet hybrids perform best when planted and /or transplanted in Spring.

Longipets (Trumpet x Longiflorum)

Easter Morn [VIII] L. Collicutt [1.4 m] Large white blooms with a trumpet shape. Reverse of petals is deep maroon while the inside edge is trimmed in pink. [EM] **Spring only.** [# Eas 70] [\$12.00]

Please remember to add extra S & H when listing trumpet and longiflorum x oriental lilies with your fall order.

L. longiflorum x Asiatic hybrid
