

SECTION I. MEMBERSHIP ) *copy*

9 Article II, \* Chartered Affiliated Organizations: "Any group consisting of a minimum of twenty-five (25) persons, of whom not less than 40% shall hold membership in the North American Lily Society, Inc. and whose primary purpose is the promotion of interest in the genus Lilium, may apply for a Charter as an organization affiliated with the North American Lily Society, Inc.. Such application shall be made in writing to the Secretary of the North American Lily Society, Inc., and upon approval of such application by the Executive Committee of the Society; such organization shall be recognized as an affiliate organization of the North American Lily Society, Inc..

Chartered affiliate organizations shall pay annual dues according to the following schedule :

- Groups with from 25 to 74 members shall pay an amount of \$25.00.
- Groups with from 75 and over members shall pay an amount of \$35.00.

*1/2 each* [3] → The North American Lily Society shall supply each such Chartered Affiliated Organizations with one (1) copy of the Annual Year Book of the Society and with five (5) copies of the bulletins published by the Society from time to time. ALL MEMBERS of such affiliated organizations shall be entitled to purchase seed from the Seed Chairman of the Society regardless of their membership in the N.A.L.S., Inc.. The privileges of the Library and Kodachrome service will also be extended to ALL members of such affiliated organizations. Any Chartered Affiliated Organization which stages a Regional Lily Show which meets the standards of the North American Lily Society, Inc. (in regard to classification, schedule and judging) shall be given official accreditation for such show and shall be entitled to receive from the Society, once each year, a trophy to be awarded at such Regional Show. The Society will endeavour to assist affiliated organizations to arrange Judging Schools, etc, wherever possible, and will help such groups in whatever way they can.

Chartered Affiliated Organizations are expected to encourage their members to donate seed to the Seed Exchange of the N.A.L.S., Inc., and are asked to refrain from holding local seed sales unless permission to do so been requested and granted by N.A.L.S., Inc.
