'Iowa Rose'

The big winner at our 2001 Lily Show was a stem of 'Iowa Rose' shown by Florence Van der Meiden from Pella, Iowa. 'Iowa Rose' is a very popular lily here in Iowa and grows so well here. This lily has captured the title 'Best of Show' three times. Aside from this year, it won the honor in 1996 with a gorgeous stem shown by Barbara Woods, Marshalltown and also in 1994 when it was shown by Josie and Marv Gronewold, Des Moines, Iowa. The following is a reprint from the NALS quarterly Bulletin, June 1, 2001.

The Story Behind Dick Prochaska's 'Iowa Rose'

'Iowa Rose' is Dick Prochaska's most famous lily hybrid. It has been awarded the certificate of commendation by the NALS and is regularly in the top ten of the annual NALS popularity poll. The parentage is a Lydia Cramer dark pink seedling pollen on Oregon Bulb Farms 'Hallmark', and that cross got 'White Prince' pollen to make 'Iowa Rose'.

But did you know that at its debut at a lily show, a sister seedling was seen as more promising hybrid? The sister seedling, a light pink, similar to cotton candy, was also exhibited at the Arboretum show in 1984. It won a blue ribbon as did 'Iowa Rose', which was also unnamed at this point. This lily attracted more attention than 'Iowa Rose'.

In his haste to show the new hybrids, Dick cut off too much of the stem, leaving only a couple inches of leaves. This lily, which Marv Truhn, among others, urged Dick to register, did not come back the next year, much to Dick's dismay. If he were to do it again, he would have waited another year to increase the stock or scaled the bulb, but hindsight is always 20/20.

Dick had better luck with 'Iowa Rose'. It was also cut in the same way for the show, but it returned and produced multiple stem bulblets which were used to increase the stock.

'Iowa Rose' was chosen the best downfacing seedling (1c) at 1985 Iowa Lily Society Show in Des Moines. His daughter Annette Wilson and her husband, Dale, took the seedling stem down to the show. Because of the win at that show, Dick decided to name the lily 'Iowa Rose' since it had also won the award for best pink downfacing seedling.

Lillian Maroushek presented the award to Dick. Hartle-Gilman Gardens recognized the lily and arranged with Dick to introduce it in their catalog.

Editors Note: From the 2000 fall bulb sale I received an upfacing soft yellow lily (rounded petals) instead of a vivid magenta 'Kiss Me Kate'. Did this happen to any one else? If so, is there a chance the lily may be identified?
